Memory boxes containing personal items showing our residents life story such as letters, photographs and any other memory triggers are evident in the home.

We understand that for the residents, their friends and families it is important that they can trust they will receive the kindest care and support delivered thoughtfulness, respect and dignity in a safe, warm, comfortable and welcoming environment.

Aldergrove Manor Care Home Activities & Information

We have a dedicated activities co-ordinator at Aldergrove, responsible for organising an in-house rolling programme of activities for our residents including themed days. We also encourage and assist residents to access community based activities wherever possible.
